Dear Friends

The INAS World Swimming Championships took place recently in Belgium. At the event, an election should have taken place for the Swimming Technical Officer position, however this did not happen.

The Executive have agreed that this will instead take place by email/post.

All member nations in good standing with INAS are invited to submit nominations for the position. This should ideally include a CV with covering letter, and an endorsement from the member nation executive committee. Nominations can be sent to me by post or email.

The closing date for nominations is Friday 2nd November.

If more than one nomination is received, then the nations competing in Belgium will be asked to vote and the decision announced before Friday 9th November.

The Swimming Technical Officer:

- is an expert in the sport in swimming, is familiar with sport for persons with intellectual disability, knows of all the rules in the able bodied international federation of swimming and the rules within IPC (if applicable)
- is a member of the technical committee of INAS-FID, specifically responsible for furthering swimming
- shall maintain a regular contact with the coordinator for swimming in IPC (if applicable)
- will be appointed by the chairman of the technical committee of INAS-FID TD (technical delegate) at competitions
- is responsible for keeping world records and rankings for swimming
- is not in charge of eligibility matters

A nation nominating a director shall, if their nominee is elected, pay for the director's travel and accommodation costs to meetings and competitions as far as not covered by hosts or organizers.

An elected director will serve until the second world championships after the one at which elected, with a maximum of four years.
