Dear Members

Further to my letter on 8th January, I am writing to remind you that, for INAS World and Regional competitions after 1st April 2008, athlete registration forms must be received by the Secretariat no less than 6 weeks before competition.

The deadline will be strictly enforced and registration forms received less than 6 weeks before competition will not be processed.

I also wish to clarify the rules regarding participation in more than one sport.

The Executive have confirmed that athletes may only compete in the sport for which they are registered. To compete in an alternative sport, a new SIC-Q must be submitted to the Secretariat. It is not necessary to send a full registration form, but pages 13-27 inclusive.

Athletes who are registered in more than one sport will have separate registration numbers for each sport. These will be clearly displayed on the INAS registration card.

A revised athlete registration form, with updated guidance notes, will be available shortly.
